RECIPES

FRUIT CAKE: 8oz flour, 6oz margarine, 6oz sugar, 4 eggs, 2oz ground almonds, 2oz glace cherries, 1 1/2 lb mixed dried fruit, 1/2 lemon, 1/2 tsp baking powder, milk to mix. Bake in approx. 8" tin at 300° for approx 2 1/2 hrs.

GLUTEN FREE CAKE: 150g margarine, 150g caster sugar, 2 eggs, 2 drops vanilla extract, 150g wheat and gluten free self-raising flour, 1 tsp gluten free baking powder, 3 tbs milk. **METHOD:** Cream marg and sugar. Beat in eggs and vanilla. Fold in flour and baking powder. Add milk. Divide into two 7" sandwich tins. Bake in moderate oven 15-20 mins.

3. All exhibits in the 16 years of age and under Sections to have been made during the 12 months October 2016 to October 2017.
4. Exhibitors to provide their saucers, vases etc. All exhibits to be staged in the Cookery Classes on cardboard plates except in Classes 25, 26 and 27.
5. The Ladies Committee will not hold themselves responsible for any loss or damage to exhibits or property.
6. All entries in Handicraft Classes to be exhibitors own work. See Rule 1.
7. Flowers for Floral Art may be bought, Classes 1 - 7. Cut flowers must be grown by exhibitor, Classes 8 - 14.
8. Competitors can take only one set of points per class per section.
